Guidelines for Evaluating Answer Scripts

1. Short Questions:

The highest limit of marking is 100% marks. Irrelevant answers shall be marked zero (00). For every three mistakes (spellings, punctuations, the use of capital and small letters, etc.), one mark shall be deducted. Grammatical accuracy shall have to be maintained strictly.

- b) If any answer is written in excess, in that case, no marks shall be deducted. But if the answer is repeated, in that case, only equivalent marks of the same answer should be reduced.
- c) If the same spelling mistakes recur in the same answer, in that case, only the first three mistakes shall be calculated as mistakes of words.

2. Word Meanings:

Full marks shall be awarded for writing correct meanings. Fifty percent marks should be deducted if the spelling mistakes are found, but in this case, the meaning of the word must not be changed.

3. Making Sentences with the Given Words:

Full marks shall be awarded for writing correct sentences. The marks shall be zero (00) if any grammatical mistakes are found. Fifty percent marks shall be deducted if any punctuation marks are wrongly used or not put down at all.

4. True/False:

Students shall write just True or False. Full marks shall be awarded for correct answers.

5. Re-arrange of Words:

Full marks shall be awarded if the answer is correct and written properly. The rules for the use of capital letters, punctuation marks, grammar, etc., must be followed or half marks shall be deducted.

6. Filling in Gaps with Clues, etc.:

full marks shall be awarded if the answer is correct.

- **7. Rhymes:** Full marks shall be awarded for correct answer.. For every mistake (spellings, punctuation marks, the uses of capital and small letters, etc.), one mark shall be deducted. But the deduction must not exceed the limit of 80% of the total marks.
- **8. Grammar:** Full marks shall be awarded if the answer is correct. Accuracy shall have to be followed strictly and the violation of the norm shall be fully penalised. In case of filling up the gaps, full sentence should be written.
- **9. Translations:** Full marks shall be awarded for writing correct, translations. Fifty percent marks shall be deducted for punctuations and spelling mistakes.
- **10. Handwriting:** Full marks shall be awarded for nice handwriting.
- 11. If any problem arises beyond the scope of the above noted guide Dept. of English shall be treated as decisive.
- **Note:** 1. For gap filling, True/False and translations, Writing down the sentences is not mandatory.
 - 2. For gap filling, True/False and translations, the question setters shall write the serial numbers of the gaps/sentences.

- 6. In the case of multiplication or division, it should be solved directly or the rough must be shown beside the solution- otherwise no marks will be awarded
- 7. Geometrical shapes must be drawn with pencil.
- 8. One mark shall be deducted if the number of the question is not written or the number of the question is written wrong

- 4. In case of writing narrative answer, related figure is a must 25 % marks shall be deducted for not giving the related figures.
- 5. In case of pointing figures full marks shall be given . In pointing simple mistake, partial marks shall be given .
- 6. Figures must be drawn with pencil . But in case of answering through table or chart , pen shall be used . Otherwise no marks shall be given.
