#### **Guidelines for Evaluating Answer Scripts: English**

#### 1. Short Questions:

- a) The highest limit of marking is full marks. Irrelevant answers shall be marked zero (00). For every three mistakes (spellings, punctuations, the uses of capital and small letters, etc.), one mark shall be deducted. Grammatical accuracy shall have to be maintained strictly.
- b. If any answer, is written in excess, in that case, no marks shall be deducted, But if the answer is repeated, in that case, only equivalent marks of the same answer should be deducted.
- c. If the same spelling mistakes recur in the same answer, in that case, only the first three mistakes shall be calculated as mistakes of words.

#### 2. Rhymes:

Full marks shall be awarded for correct answer. For every mistake (spellings, punctuation marks, the uses of capital and small letters, etc.), one mark shall be deducted. But the deduction must not exceed limit of eighty percent of the total marks.

#### 3. Making Sentences with the given words:

Hundred percent marks shall be awarded for writing correct sentences. The marks shall be zero (00) if any grammatical mistake is found. Fifty percent marks shall be deducted if any punctuation marks is wrongly used or not put down at all.

#### 4. Translations/Retranslations:

Hundred percent marks shall be awarded for writing correct translations/retranslations. Fifty percent marks shall be deducted for punctuations and spelling mistakes.

#### 5. Word meanings:

Hundred percent marks shall be awarded for writing correct meanings. The marks shall be zero (00) if any spelling mistakes is found.

#### 6. Rearranging Words:

100% marks shall be awarded if the answer is correct and written properly. The rules for the uses of capital letters, punctuation marks, grammar, etc. must be followed or 50% percent marks shall be deducted.

#### 7. True/False:

Students shall write just True or False full marks shall be awarded for correct answers.

#### 8. Fill in the gaps with clues:

In case of filling up the gaps of sentences with appropriate word after the text, hundred percent marks shall be awarded. But in case of violation of the said norm, marks shall be zero (00).

#### 9. Fill in the gaps with articles:

In case of filling up the gaps of sentences with appropriate articles after the text, hundred percent marks shall be awarded. But in case of violation of the said norm, marks shall be zero (00).

#### 10. Fill in the gaps with verbs:

In case of filling up the gaps of sentences with appropriate forms of verbs after the text, hundred percent marks shall be awarded. But in case of violation of the said norm, marks shall be zero (00).

#### 11. Paragraph Writing:

- (i) Full marks shall be awarded. The paragraph must be written in one paragraph. For every three mistakes (spellings, punctuations, the uses of small and capital letters, etc.) one mark shall be deducted.
- (ii) If the paragraph is written in more than one paragraph, in that case, the marking must be zero (00).
- (iii) Irrelevant answer shall be marked zero (00).

#### 12. Handwriting:

If the handwriting is nice, full marks shall be awarded.

**Note.** If any problem arises beyond the scope of the above noted guidelines, in that case, the decisions taken by the Department of English shall be treated as decisive.

**Note:** 1. For gap filling, True/False and translations, Writing down the sentences is not mandatory.

2. For gap filling, True/False and translations, the question setters shall write the serial numbers of the gaps/sentences.

# Guidelines for evaluating answer scripts Mathematics

- 1. If the unit is not written in the answer or is written incorrectly, I mark will be deducted.
- 2. If the answer is correct but there are errors in the solution steps, no marks will be awarded.
- 3. 1 mark will be deducted for both writing the answer incorrectly and not writing it at all.
- 4. If additional questions are answered, the first answers will be accepted, and the later ones will be crossed out.
- 5. For any answer in arithmetic, 1 mark will be deducted for language errors. However, no marks will be awarded for language errors that result in a different meaning.
- 6. Rough work must be provided for calculations in the problems; otherwise, no marks will be awarded.
- 7. Geometric figures must be drawn with a hard pencil; if drawn with a pen, no marks will be awarded.
- 8. If the geometric figure is incorrect, no marks will be awarded. If the description is not written or is written incorrectly, 1 mark will be deducted. In the case of drawing straight lines, arrow marks must be given.
- 9. Multiplication or division must be shown directly in the answer sheet or rough work must be provided beside the solution. Otherwise, marks will not be awarded. (Calculators are not acceptable.)
- 10. 1 mark will be deducted if the question number is not written or is written incorrectly on the answer sheet.

**Note:** If any problems arise outside of the above rules, the decision of the mathematics teachers of this school will be considered final.

- 1. For definitional questions with examples, 1 mark will be given for the correct definition, and 1/2 mark will be given for the example. If the definition is incomplete, no marks will be given. If only an example is given, marks will be provided only for the example.
- 2. For difference or comparative questions, marks will be given for each difference or comparison. If half of each difference or comparison is correct, no partial marks for writing wrong difference.
- 3. For descriptive questions, full marks will be given if the answer is correct. Marks will be deducted proportionally for spelling errors, irrelevant content, or disruptions in sequence. If diagrams, charts, or tables are appropriate, full marks will be given.

# Guidelines for Evaluating Answer Scripts Bangladesh and Global Studies

- 1. Full marks will be awarded for answers written in paragraphs with proper source citations.
- For difference or comparative questions, marks will be awarded for each distinct difference or comparison. If only half of a difference or comparison is correct, no marks will be given for that part.
- 3. For descriptive questions, a maximum of 95% marks will be awarded if the answer is comprehensive and taken directly from the textbook. Full marks can be given if the answer is comprehensive, correct, and demonstrates originality.
- 4. Drawings or maps drawn without a hard pencil are not acceptable. However, charts and tables must be written in pen. A score of zero will be given if written in hard pencil.
- 5. The examiner may deduct marks proportionally for spelling errors, lack of coherence, irrelevant content, or poor handwriting in the answers.
- 6. One mark will be deducted if the identification is not written on maps/diagrams.
- 7. For fill-in-the-blank or true-false questions, the complete sentence must be written along with the answer. Otherwise, no marks will be given.
- 8. A score of zero (00) will be given if the multiple-choice question is incorrect.
- 9. Marks will be deducted for incomplete answers. That is, if a question has multiple parts, marks will be deducted for the parts that are not answered.
- 10. Multiple-choice answers cannot be written in pencil.
- 11. For multiple-choice answers, the correct word or sentence must be written in the designated answer space. No marks will be given if writing A, B, C, or D in the answer space.
